

Biography

Born close to Frankfurt/Main, Konrad Engel grew up in a scientifically oriented family. However it came clear already during his early childhood that music would be his vocation some day. More than a dozen scholarships and awards reinforced that over the years.

His academic studies were crowned by the „Konzertexamen“ with Prof. K.-H. Kämmerling in 2006. Many international masterclasses completed his artistic education, such as the Wilhelm-Kempff-Academy with John O’Conor.

Before he has chosen to reduce his international career as concert artist after almost 30 years to a minimum and rather focus on pedagogical aspects, he performed with numerous renowned orchestras and at several international festivals.

His more than 20 years of teaching experience include a lectureship at Bremen music university and a temporary professorship in Hanover. Since 2017 Konrad Maria Engel is professor at „Hanns Eisler“ university and head of piano department at „Bach-Gymnasium“ Berlin. By now amongst his students are many prizewinners at international competitions.

Konrad Engel is giving international masterclasses also regarding methodology, improvisation and music theory.
